Gundagai Rail Trail Project Supporter Invitation

The Gundagai Rail Trail Supporters Committee formed in 2015 to provide support to Council to develop the Gundagai Rail Trail. The Gundagai Rail Trail will be a 32km shared trail from Coolac to Tumblong along the decommissioned Tumut Branch Line Rail Corridor. In 2009 Council and Riverina Regional Development funded a feasibility study for the rail trail project which indicated feasibility for the project and suggested an annual return of \$1 million. A pilot project recently developed along the Tumbarumba-Rosewood Rail Corridor has set a precedent for rail trails to be built in NSW. A detailed development study including full Gundagai Railway Viaduct engineering study are essential to put Council in a position to apply for funding from the NSW Government and funds are required for these studies to be completed.

Gundagai Regional Enhancement Group (GREG) (ABN 26 110 757 133) is partnering with the Foundation for Rural & Regional Renewal (FRRR) (ABN 27 091 810 589) to enable effective fundraising for this project, which is charitable and in line with FRRR's purposes.
